How has it been interpreted?

- It's mostly already happened soon after writing. The Preterist view
- It's mostly yet to happen shortly before the End. The Futurist view
- It's happening right now it covers all of history. The Historicist view
- It doesn't "happen" at all it describes timeless truths. The Idealist view

Some starting points to interpret it

- It was written to Christians in a historical context
- It is relevant at all times, everywhere.
- It is consistent with the rest of the Bible.
- It is in "Apocalyptic" style & the source for symbolism is the Old Testament.
- It is prophetic literature, and can have many layers of fulfilment.


12:1-15:8 Seven(?) Signs
