Genesis 1-11









A summary of our bible overview – for reference

	Divine provision/promise	Human Reality Check	But God by grace
Genesis 1-11	Made us in his image (Gen 1-2)	We rebel against God (Gen 3)	Promised one who will crush the snake (Gen 3:15)
Genesis 12-50	Made a covenant with Abraham and his descendants (Gen 12:1-7)	They were not ready to receive them (Gen 50:24)	Keeps his promise (by grace through faith in Christ)
Exodus - Deuteronomy	Freed his people and gave his law through Moses (Exodus 20:1-3)	Israel failed to keep them	Provided a sacrifice to atone for sin
Joshua-Esther	Gave his people kings to rule over them	David's sons proved to be unworthy	Promised a true King who will reign forever (2 Sam 7:14)
Job-Songs of Songs	Gave his people wisdom to live by	Without God all is meaningless (Eccles 1:2)	Promised purpose in all every aspect life (Prov. 1:7)
Isaiah - Malachi	Gave warning of judgements (Zeph 1:7)	The nation failed to listen	Promised salvation to come (Zeph 3:14-20)
Matthew - John	God the Son became human, died and rose again (John 1:1, 14; Mark 8:29, 31)	We must repent and follow him (Mark 8:34)	Saves us and gives us life himself, through Christ (John 1:12)
Acts	He commands his followers to spread the Good News (Acts 1:8)	They cannot do it on their own	Provides his spirit to empower the task (Acts 1:8)
Romans-Jude	He explains the Christian faith (eg Col 1:15-23)	We are vulnerable to error and prone to sin (Eg Col 2:8, 3:5)	Explains the Christian life (Eg 3:12)
Revelation	He will return to judge the heavens and earth	We will face many trials	Promises his people a new heaven and earth
